In cases where FRA concludes that an operation is not a railroad for purposes of 49 U. S. C. 20102 (1), local rail service providers, often agencies of state or local governments, may receive capital or operating funds from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA). However, FTA has no statutory authority for safety regulation. Instead, in the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) of 1992, the Congress directed states to designate agencies with safety regulatory responsibility for fixed guideway transportation (including heavy rail, light rail, funiculars, monorails, etc.). State inspectors working with transit properties, however, are not required to be familiar with FRA track safety standards (which may not, in fact, be appropriate for transit systems in all...
